CAMPER'S AGREEMENT *to follow* MGTA POLICIES & CODE OF CONDUCT

Dear MGTA Family:

Due to the multi-cultural nature of our community and the variety of value systems and expectations of behavior with which our campers arrive at our doorstep we feel it necessary to clearly state our Code of Conduct and express the seriousness with which we require its adherence by each member of our MGTA Family. The following codes are enforced to ensure a safe, successful and enjoyable summer for all:

- **Treat Others As You Wish To Be Treated**
NO ONE is allowed to have fun at the expense of another.
We WILL NOT tolerate disrespectful and/or inappropriate behavior to peers or staff.
Bullying, teasing, and any other form of verbal or physical assault may result in dismissal from camp.
- **Always Leave your Campsite in a Better Condition Than You Found It**
Defacing camp property will not be tolerated.
Any camper causing any damage to camp property will be billed for damages and may be asked to leave camp.
- **Safety First**
All potentially dangerous items - knives (Swiss Army, boy scout, etc.), lighters, laser pointers, heating coils, aerosol cans, scissors, fireworks, etc. are strictly prohibited. Such items will be confiscated and the campers may be sent home.
- **Alcohol, Drug and Smoke Free**
MGTA strictly prohibits the possession or use of alcohol, illegal drugs and cigarettes.
Staff or campers involved in any incidents involving these substances will be removed from camp immediately at the camp's sole discretion.

Campers will be reminded of these Policies and their agreement to follow them upon their arrival during Camper Orientation.

We are committed to maintaining the safest, healthiest, and happiest experience possible for each and every camper. We know our campers want the same and expect each one to observe all our policies during the summer. Please read the following policies on the back of this page and review each carefully with your children prior to camp. Make sure that you clearly describe and discuss these guidelines and these consequences for not following each for your child.

| Campers are not permitted to possess and/or consume in any manner, or be in the presence of someone using or possessing, illegal drugs and/or prescriptive medicines or drugs unless prescribed by a physician and registered immediately upon arrival with the Infirmary. | Immediate dismissal from camp |
| Campers are not permitted to possess or consume or be in the presence of someone possessing or consuming, alcoholic beverages of any type. | Immediate dismissal from camp |
| Smoking by campers is strictly prohibited (cigarettes, cigars, pipes) anywhere. | Loss of privileges and parental involvement |
| No camper shall act in a violent or aggressive manner, or cause physical assault, or cause to threaten such behavior. No camper shall tease, bully, or pick on another camper | Loss of privileges, possible cabin change, parental involvement, possible dismissal |
| Campers are required to attend all activities except when excused by a Director or excused for reasons of health by the Infirmary | First time - Discussion with camper and guidance Second time – Discipline and loss of privileges Third time – Parental involvement |
| Willful damage to camp property and equipment is a serious offense. All campers are expected to treat all property and equipment with the care and respect accorded to their own personal property. | Loss of privileges, maintenance work, and parents held responsible for cost of repair or replacement |
| Defacing camp property in any way will not be tolerated. Any graffiti including writing, drawing, carving, or painting names or pictures on furniture, cabins, or building walls are all examples of this and will be considered a serious offense | Loss of privileges, maintenance work, and parents held responsible for cost and repair or replacement |
| Theft of camp's or other person's property, however small is a serious offense | Loss of privileges and parents advised, restitution to be made. |
| No camper is permitted to possess or use fire, candles, mosquito coils or fireworks of any kind | Confiscation, parental involvement |
| No camper is permitted to possess a knife or any kind of other sharp or dangerous tool or weapon, real or fake | Confiscation, parental involvement |
| No camper is permitted to tamper with any safety devices including fire alarms, and fire extinguishers | Loss of privileges and parental involvement |
| No campers shall bring to camp a cellular phone or use the camp phone without permission of a Camp Director | Confiscation of cellular phone and parental involvement |
